Search Progress is available through Assignments in Microsoft Teams for Education. This Learning Accelerator helps students practice information literacy skills.

1 Create

Create a Search Progress assignment in just a few simple steps. Simply start by creating an assignment, selecting Learning Accelerators, and then choosing Search Progress from the list.

2 Customize

Customize assignment settings including the number of sources that students need to collect, as well as prompts for reflection and metacognition throughout the research process.

3 Practice

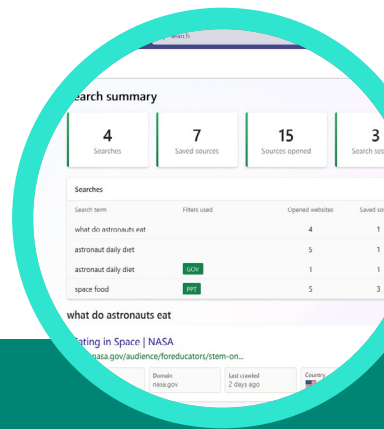
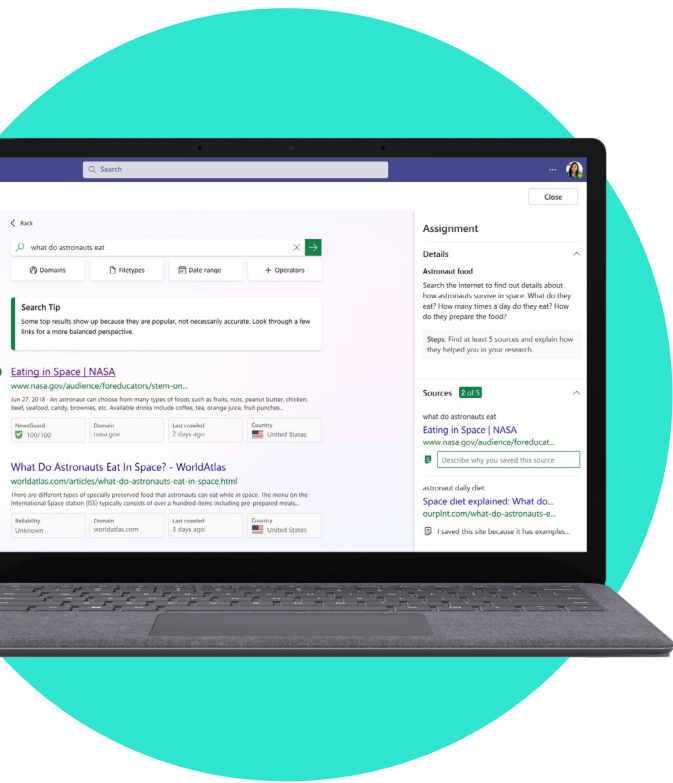
Help students practice information literacy skills with built-in features that improve gathering and evaluating sources.
